NOTE: Best Drama, Comedy, Actor, Actress, Male Costume, and Female Costume will be chosen by arbitration by the judges at the end of the event.

NOTICE TO ALL PARTICIPANTS:

All groups and performers are to follow Safety Rules and Guidelines at all times. Groups and performers must have reenactment insurance to compete. Insurance may be purchased through RGA or other expectable insurance carriers, but must be at least one week before event in order to be added. No crimped blanks will be allowed.

Participants wishing to carry a firearm MUST attend the Safety Meeting on Saturday September 8, 2012. To fire, a participant must also complete the Splatter test at the meeting. An Injury Release and "Hold-Harmless" Agreement must be signed by all participants at event check-in.
